Ans. The system of printing for the blind is known as Braille.



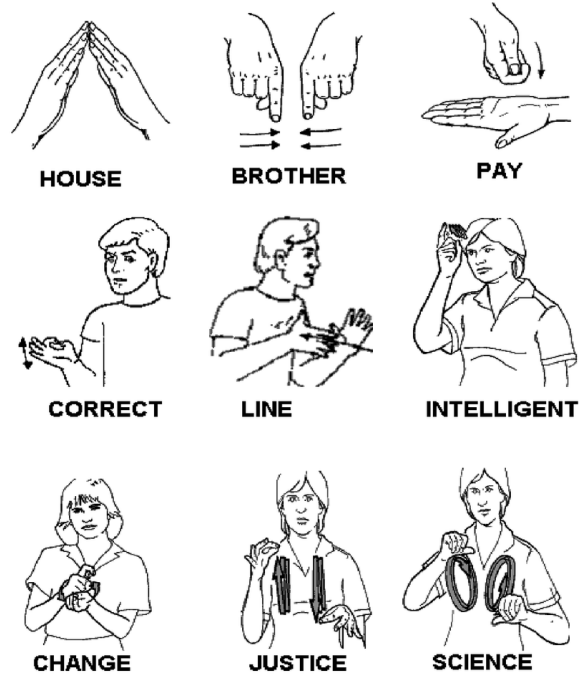
Q2. What is the short form of non-governmental organisation?
