It was built by the Rhodians in the 3rd century B.C.

It stood for sixty years before an earthquake destroyed it.

It inspired the Statue of Liberty.

Ans. The lighthouse of Alexandria was located on the small island of Pharos near Alexandria in Egypt.

At the top of the lighthouse the statue of Alexander the Great had been erected.
