Que1:- Give one reason why Hindus build many temples?



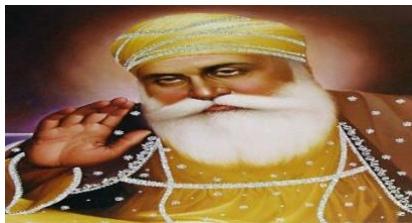
Ans- Hindus build many temples because they have different temples for different Gods.

Que2:- How many times a day do Muslims pray? What are these prayers called?



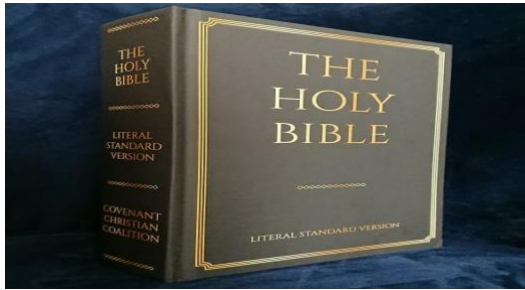
Ans- Muslims pray five times in a day. These prayers are called "Namaz".
