Answer these questions:

Q1. Under which three types can we group our civil services?

Ans. Various kinds of civil services can be grouped under- central, state and All-India civil services.

Q2. Name any three civil services about which you have learnt in this chapter.

Ans. In this chapter we have learnt about -

- The Indian Administrative Service (IAS)
- The Indian Police Service (IPS)
- The Indian Foreign Service (IFS).

Q3. What role does the Indian Revenue Service play?

Ans. The IPS officers get trained at the Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel National Police Academy, Hyderabad.

Q6. Who are civil servants? What do they do?

Ans. The officials that are employed by the Union Public Service Commission, and form the civil service are called civil servants.

Ans. The three types of civil services work for the central and state governments.

Q8. Describe the work of the IAS officer.

Ans. The work of IAS officers are:

- It manages the everyday work of the government according to a set of rules.
- It carries out the plans of the government, like getting development work done.
- IAS officers are in charge of different government departments and organisations that deal with different things such as health, education, electricity and agriculture.

Q9. Write four things that IPS officers do.

Ans The IPS officers do the following:

- Maintain peace and order, prevent and investigate crimes.
- IPS officers also lead police units that fight terrorists.
- The senior officers of CBI are IPS officers. They investigate crimes that affect the whole country.

Q10. What is the role of Indian Foreign Service officers?

Ans.

- The senior IFS officers are posted to different countries, where they represent India.
- They work to improve our ties with other countries in fields like trade, culture and education.
- The highest-ranking IFS officer in a foreign country is the ambassador.

Q11. Who is the highest ranking I.A.S. in a district?

Ans. The District Magistrate is the highest ranking I.A.S. official in a district.

Q12. Who selects and appoints the officers of I.A.S., I.P.S and I.F.S.?

Ans. The U.P.S.C.Union service public commission appoints them.
