Ans. Municipality looks after the needs of the residents of a town or a city.





Ans. If a town has 15 wards then there would be 15 councillors in that city.


Q3. What is the head of a municipal corporation called?

Q4. For how many years are councillors elected?


Ans. Councillors are elected for a term of 5 years.
