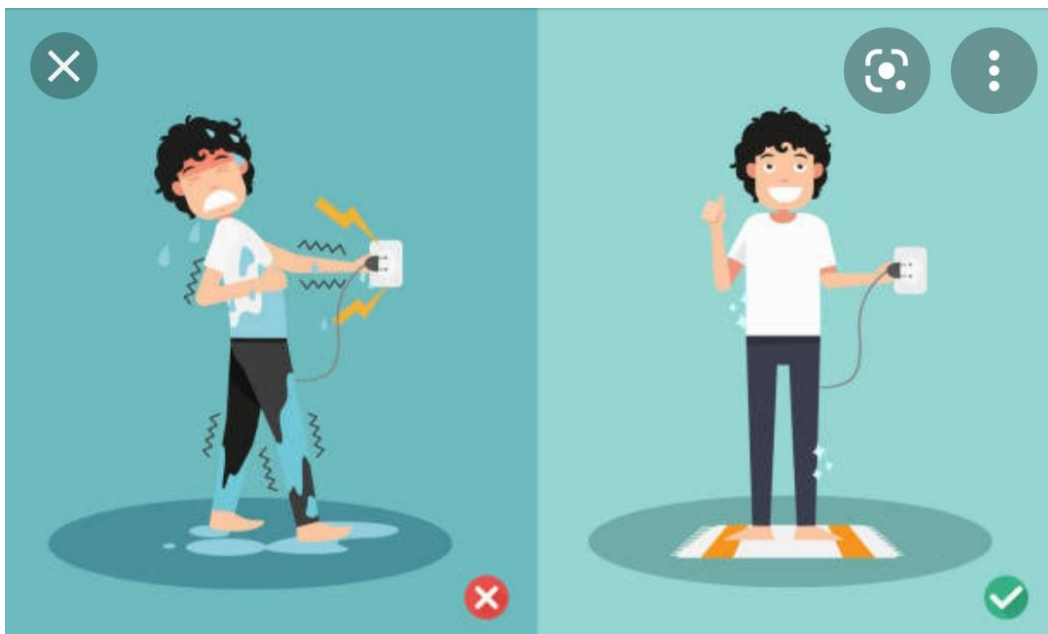

Q.1 What is the importance of first aid ?

***Do not touch electric appliances or sockets with your wet hands. You may get an electric shock.**



***Always consume medicines under the supervision of an adult.**

***Immediately wipe off any liquid that has been spilled on the floor ,to avoid any injury.**
