iv. I may do my homework. I may read a book.

-I shall either do my homework or read a book.

v. I may go by train. I may take a bus.

- I shall either go by train or take a bus.

vi. I may see a doctor. I may go to the hospital.

-I Shall either see a doctor or go to the hospital.

vii. We may have a lesson. We may watch television.

-We shall have either a lesson or watch television.

viii. We may stay on the beach. We may go to the cinema.

-We shall either stay on the beach or go to the cinema.

c. Sometimes the weather is hot and wet. Sometimes it is cold and dry.

-The weather is either hot and wet or cold and dry.

Sometimes the wind blows from the north. Sometimes it blows from the south.

-The wind blows either from the north or from the south.

-Cyclones either travel north or north-west.
